## Asheforde Oaks Home Owners Association Pool Rules / Restrictions for the Summer of 2020

Pool Hours: Tuesday – Saturday 12:00PM – 8:00PM

Sunday – 1:00PM – 8:00PM

Closed Mondays (except Memorial Day and Labor Day)

Your HOA Board considers your health and safety of great importance during this unusual time that we are living in. According to the most recent information provided by the CDC and the Oklahoma County Health Department, there is no evidence that COVID-19 can be spread to humans through treated pool water, as the virus is susceptible to destruction / inactivation by property sanitizer levels (chlorine/bromine). Therefore, the Asheforde Oaks Home Owners Association Board will follow the recommendations of the Oklahoma County Health Department and our Pool Management Company (Northwest Pool Management) whereby enforcing the following additional rules / restrictions for the Summer of 2020.

- All residents and guests swim at their own risk; which includes the risk of COVID-19 Virus contamination / infection.
- Lifeguard / Northwest Pool Management decisions are final.
- All residents (Pool Members) must sign-in Name, Address, and Time-in and Time-out.
- Comply with General Social Distancing Guidelines currently in place.
- No more than 25 persons allowed in the Pool facility at one time.
- No Groups / Gatherings within the Pool facility area of 10 or more people.
- Individuals / Family Groups must be separated by a least 6 feet, both in and out of the Water.
- Resident Rotation Residents are permitted 2 hours of swim time and then must rotate out.
- It is recommended that people wear face masks to help prevent / slow the spread of the virus. Masks should not be worn the water, as it may cause respiratory distress when wet.
- Resident(s) cannot be in the Pool facility if they have had symptoms of COVID-19, such as: diarrhea
  in the last two weeks, cough, fever, chills, headache, sore throat, recent loss of taste or smell. This
  list is not all inclusive, please consult your medical provider for any other symptoms that are
  concerning to you.
- It is recommended residents bring their own disinfecting wipes to disinfect furniture and/or tables they have used.
- Please wash hands before entering the pool facility, even if you do not intend on swimming.
- Must shower before entering the pool.
- No Pool Parties.
- No Swim Team.
- No Swim Lessons.
- Extending and/or more frequent Safety Breaks to provide time to disinfect handles, ladders, handrails and other such surfaces that are frequently touched.
- Refreshments / Popsicles will not be provided during Safety Breaks.
- In cases where compliance with these rules / restrictions are infeasible or cannot be achieved due to lack of cooperation by patrons or other issues, the pool will be closed indefinitely or until compliance can be achieved and maintained, or until the rules / restrictions are further relaxed.
